§ 1 General Nomenclature

For reference within both governmental and public sectors, the following names and terms may be used:

1. This document is filed as DFR 6/2025 in Fellinese records.
2. In international contexts, the name of the signing location is used; therefore, in this case, the treaty shall be called *Treaty of Mutual Recognition between Fellino and Aericia*.
 - a. Other possible names include *Fellino–Aericia Treaty*.
3. The expression *signatory nations* refers to the nations involved in the signing of this document.

§ 2 General Provisions of the Treaty

In pursuit of genuine and lasting friendship and cooperation, the Principality of Fellino, whose capital is the City of Fellino, and the Aeric Empire whose capital is Montréal, agree to mutually recognize each other and to establish formal diplomatic relations.

§ 3 Diplomacy

1. In addition to their respective Heads of State, the signatory nations shall each appoint an official, a citizen of their respective State, to act as a formal or de facto representative of relations between the two States; a symbolic diplomatic office shall also be assigned.
 - a. For Fellino, the Viceroy is appointed.
 - b. For Aeric, His Excellency Tristan Glark, Head of the Diplomacy and Foreign Ministry of the Aeric Empire, is appointed.
2. All formal diplomatic communication between the two States and their representatives may take place through diplomatic channels of their respective community networks or through private correspondence between the representatives. The language adopted for such communication is English.
3. Any conflict between the two signatory States shall be resolved through diplomatic dialogue.
4. Any communication made by delegates or Heads of State of the two signatory States shall remain private unless mutual consent is given for disclosure.
 - a. Informal dialogue outside diplomatic contexts is not included.

§ 4 Recognition

1. The signatory States mutually recognize the legitimacy of each other's territorial claims.
2. The signatory States recognize the legitimacy and authority of each other's governments and governmental institutions.
3. The signatory States recognize noble and political titles within each other's nations.

§ 5 Terms of the Treaty

1. Any pre-existing treaty of mutual recognition involving the participating sovereign States, whether bilateral or multilateral, shall be suspended in accordance with the conditions described in the respective legislation.
2. Any breach of protocol established in the Treaty shall be resolved through formal and diplomatic dialogue.
3. Any act of hostility by one of the signatory States toward the other shall immediately render the Treaty null and void.
4. A signatory State wishing to suspend the validity of the Treaty must express its decision at least one week in advance.
 - a. During the period preceding the dissolution of the Treaty, reconciliation or diplomatic restoration dialogues may take place.

§ 6 Signatories

The following signatures and any accompanying seals confirm the approval of the Treaty's terms by each respective nation.

The Treaty was formally approved by the Government of the Principality of Fellino for signing and ratification by the Head of State of Fellino and the Representative of the People on November 13, 2025.

The Treaty was formally approved by the Government of the Aerican Empire for signing and ratification by the Head of the Diplomacy and Foreign Ministry of the Aerican Empire on October 24, 2025.
